

### For the Month Ended July 31, 2017






### **OPERATING INCOME (LOSS):**




### **CHANGE IN NET POSITION:**



## **VIG - STACK YARD**

- The stack yard is starting to take shape.
- Stacks 28 & 29 are visible
- The first cranes will ship from Poland in late January 2018.
- The stacks will be delivered in early February.
- Stacks 27-29 will be in production on April 9,2018
- We feel this effort is slightly behind schedule at the moment








### POV RAIL VS GATE/BARGE VOLUME








### **VIG RAIL VS GATE/BARGE VOLUME**
