








CHANGE IN NET POSITION:















POV OSHA LOST WORK DAY RATE






POV RAIL VS GATE/BARGE VOLUME






NIT RAIL VS GATE/BARGE VOLUME






VIG RAIL VS GATE/BARGE VOLUME










NIT GATE TURN TIMES








